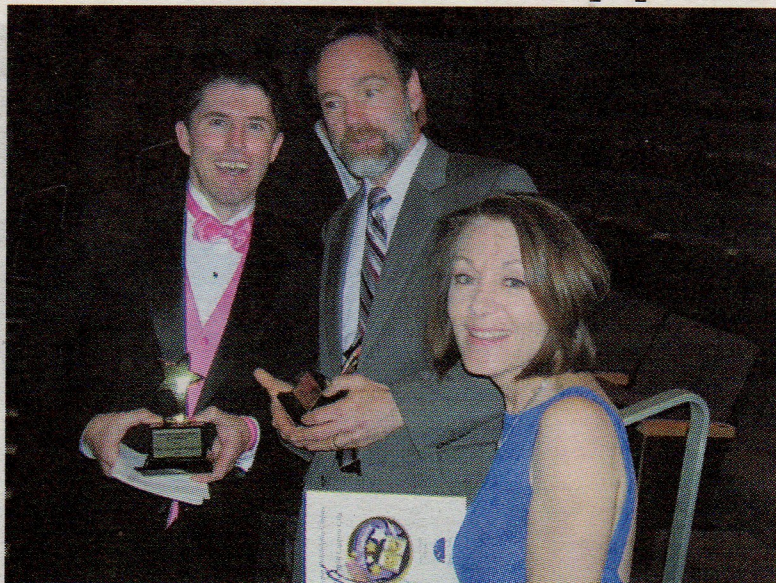


Casey Feldman Honored At Cappies

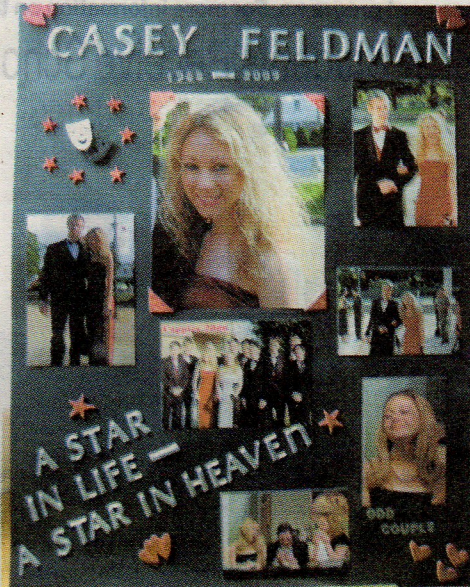
Casey Feldman, a 2006 Springfield High School graduate who was killed in July 2009 while crossing a street in Ocean City, N.J., was awarded a special Cappie for her dedication to theater and journalism. Casey was secretary of the Springfield Theater Workshop at SHS, acted in five plays during her tenure at SHS, was lead critic from SHS for the Cappies in 2005-2006, was nominated for a Cappie in 2006 and accepted the Cappie on behalf of the entire

cast of the Odd Couple for Best Play at the Cappies in 2006. Casey was a senior and Journalism student at Fordham University at the time of her accident.

John Gildea presented the award, which was accepted by Casey's parents, Dianne Anderson and Joel Feldman. The male members of the Laramie Project cast wore pink ties and vests in honor of Casey. The cast members thanked Casey as they accepted their Cappies awards.
